About Autscape

Autscape is the first event of its kind in Europe. The majority of the organizers, presenters and participants are autistic. The environment, schedule, social expectations and presentations are all designed for autistic people; effort is made to minimise sensory and social stressors.

Autscape is a retreat, educational conference and social gathering, where you can socialise, learn, participate in activities and just be yourself. All activities are optional. Autistic behaviour such as repetitive movements (stimming), obsessions and shutdown are accepted as long as it does not infringe on the rights or safety of others.

This Year's Venue

Accommodation: Rooms are shared between two people. A limited number of single rooms are available. Some bedrooms have wireless access.

Bathroom facilities are shared. All bedrooms are close to both a bathroom and a kitchenette which has tea and coffee making facilities.

The venue is wheelchair accessible. Please let us know if you will need access to these facilities.

Meals are served in a communal dining hall with a smaller annexe opening off it; you may also take your meal out of the hall.

If you have a special dietary requirement please let us know when you register.

Attendance at Autscape includes 3 nights accommodation and 3 meals per day. Non-residential attendance includes all meals except breakfast and attendance on all days.

What Happens at Autscape

Autscape has a variety of activities, scheduled and casual, lecture style and interactive. All are optional. You may choose to do things alone, with others, or not at all.



Presentations: There will be presentations on topics of interest to autistic people, with an emphasis this year on effective daily living. Past topics have included activism, relationships, communication, organisations and support services.

Workshops: Hands-on workshops in communication, art and online resources have been a popular part of the Autscape programme

Discussions: Facilitated discussions on different topics will be scheduled daily.

Socialising without pressure: Autscape is a great opportunity to meet other autistic people. All participants are provided with colour-coded badges to let others know whether interaction is welcome.

Leisure activities: There are both structured and unstructured activities such as board games, singing, watching films, going for walks or enjoying a drink with friends.
