4.3. Joan asked in relation to the Safeguarding policy: When the Autscape Safeguarding officer becomes aware of a concern do they pass it on to the authorities as per Autscapes policy because a recent post on the Autscape facebook page indicated that a matter was decided internally by the board.

The Company secretary explained that if a Safeguarding incident is brought to the attention of the Safeguarding officer at an event then the policy is followed. The policy sets out what steps to take and if necessary it would be passed to the authorities. However, a recent matter came to the boards attention after the event so the board had to look at the allegations to determine what action they needed to take. In this particular case they found that no actual incident at taken place at an event so they did not need to contact the authorities.

Martijn pointed out that a statement had been made which covered the boards actions in the above case.

4.4. Joan asked if the Safeguarding policy was in line with the Charities Commissions recommendations.

The Company secretary said the Safeguarding policy was in line with legislation which included the Charities Commission recommendations.

4.5. Joseph asked if the board intended making a decision on whether the person from the above allegations is able to attend Autscape in the future or continue as a volunteer, and make its decision known to members.

The Company secretary said the board had yet to make any decision on this but they planned to do so soon. If possible we will communicate this decision to the members.
